

Andrew Millinchip M.A. (Oxon), F.R.C.O.(CHM), was educated at King Edward's School, Birmingham, where he studied the organ with Roy Massey, until recently organist of Hereford Cathedral. After leaving school he held the Maria Blanche Gibbs Organ Scholarship at Keble College, Oxford, where he read for a degree in music. He has given many organ recitals in this country and abroad, including a European tour with the choir of Ampleforth College, Yorkshire.

He is also an experienced singer, having been, at various times, a member of Birmingham Cathedral Choir, the Schola Cantorum of Oxford, the choir of Jesus College, Cambridge, and the New Barbican Singers in London. Andrew is in demand as an accompanist on both the piano and the organ, and has worked recently with Frodsham Choral Society, Sandbach Voices and the Cheshire Boys' Choir.

After teaching in Essex he became the Director of Music at The Grange in 1983. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Organists and holds their choir-training diploma. In addition to composing some of the music to Colin Gordon-Farleigh's lyrics, he also sings with Cantoris.
